Health fair and flu shots!

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We are once again offering the County Health Fair with blood work available for the below pricing and flu shots for all employees currently on the County Health Insurance. If you have County Insurance or another insurance that will cover the flu shots see below.

The Lawrence County Health Fair and Flu shots

October 14th from 7am to 9am in the EOC training room by the EM Office.

- The Quadrivalent Flu shots are free for County Insured Employees and covered family members.

YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE A (Legible) COPY OF BOTH SIDES OF YOUR INSURANCE CARD

and your Date of Birth FOR THE FLU SHOT PRIOR TO THE 14th to RENE'

- If you have other insurance that will cover the shot but is not the County insurance, provide a copy of both sides of your card **PRIOR** to the day of the fair to the RENE'.
- **Flu shots are available for non-insured employees for a fee.**

Employees:

If you are participating in the Health Fair blood tests, the tests are fasting, **DO NOT** eat or drink anything except water after midnight. You will need to sign the consent form before you get your blood drawn. Forms for the blood tests will be available at the Auditor's office copy room and on the EM office door **prior** to the day of the fair.

The Cost for an employee for the blood work:

- \$20 **PSA** (Prostate Specific Antigen) Test **MALES ONLY**; this will also include **CMP, Cholesterol, VIT D, IRON and CBC** (blood Sugar).
- \$ 20 for the **TSH** (Thyroid) Test includes **your TSH, CMP, Cholesterol, VIT D, Iron and CBC.**
- \$15.00 for the **CBC, CMP, VIT D, Iron and Cholesterol** combo only.
- \$25.00 For any Male employee who wants to have the **PSA, Thyroid, CBC, CMP, Vit D, Iron and Cholesterol.**

Please have **cash** or a **check** made out to Lead Deadwood Monument Hospital on the day of the fair.

These tests give you a lot more information that you can review and discuss with your Doctor. Any irregularities will be in bold to allow you to know what test results may need further attention. The results will be distributed in envelopes when we get them back from the lab.

Information will be provided on a variety of health subjects along with coffee, fruit, juice and breakfast bars. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
