According to your kmz file, Gudat Road is being used for access to all properties in this larger parcel, including the 4-acre parcel that is going to be added. According to our records, Gudat Road is a Secondary County Road. We removed the Forest Service road designation in 2015 to a county road designation. I double-checked Lawrence County GIS website and it also shows Gudat Road as a Secondary County Road.

I am confused as to why the county is requiring a permit from the Forest Service on a county road. We do not issue permits or easements on roads that are already open for public use and especially for roads that are county jurisdiction.

You may provide my contact information to the county if they want to contact me regarding this issue. I am curious as to their requirements and how they align with our regulation and policy.
