

**CONTRACT FOR MEDICAL SERVICES LAWRENCE COUNTY
JAIL**

Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital will provide the services of a Physician, a Physician's Assistant (PA), or Nurse Practitioner (NP) to come to the Lawrence County Jail for the purpose of examining inmates who have been incarcerated for 15 days. Assessment of physical condition will be documented and patients will be treated "on-site" or by video whenever feasible during scheduled time frames. A pre-arranged time will be mutually agreed upon by the jail and Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital, which will be approximately once every two weeks for approximately one hour for each visit. The schedule will be coordinated between the two facilities, the first and third Thursdays of each month at a pre-arranged time. The jail will contact the hospital to schedule.

Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital will provide medical supplies to include a blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, otoscope, etc. and any other screening medical equipment necessary to perform a physical examination.

A copy of the record of the documentation of the assessment will be preserved at the Lawrence County Jail; the original will be maintained at Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital.

Flexibility of scheduling will be coordinated as the need arises and communication will be made to the Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital scheduler if no visit is necessary, or if a visit is needed sooner than scheduled. The jail will notify Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital if a visit is not necessary, 24 hours before the scheduled visit.

All acutely ill inmates will be transported and treated at the Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital.

An hourly fee will be billed to the Lawrence County Jail for services rendered. This fee will be \$136.50 per hour for the Physician, PA, or NP time and any other personnel from Monument Health Lead-Deadwood Hospital working simultaneously with the Physician, PA, or NP. In addition, a fee of \$51.10 per hour for Nursing personnel, LPN or RN, or Paramedic will be charged if that individual is required to visit the jail at a specific time separate from that of the Physician, PA, or NP, to prepare medication list, etc. for the Physician, PA, or NP, thus resulting in a decrease in the time expended and billed for the Physician, PA, or NP. A minimum of one hour will be billed for each visit. All fees will be billed on a monthly basis.

This agreement will be effective July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
