Dear Mr. Outka:

Ducks Unlimited in the Black Hills would like to host two fund raising events in Lawrence County this spring. The Lookout Chapter, based in Spearfish, has scheduled a casino night on Monday, June 17, at Crow Peak Brewing Co. in Spearfish. The event will include a few games, raffles, and both a live and a silent auction. Prizes for the winners of the games and raffles will include firearms for the winners, with lesser prizes for 2nd and 3rd prizes. We anticipate the festivities will conclude by about 8:30 pm.

The Tri-State Chapter, based in Belle Fourche, would like to operate a Queen of Hearts game, also at Crow Peak Brewing. This game is a progressive game where chances for the weekly drawing may be purchased at the bar. One ticket is drawn from all those purchasing chances and that one weekly winner selects one of a deck of cards, looking for the Queen of Hearts. If the heart queen is not drawn, the weekly winner gets 10% of the value of the tickets sold for that week, and the remaining 90% of the weekly ticket sales is added to the accumulated jackpot. If the weekly ticket winner selects the Queen of Hearts, that winner receives 50% of the accumulated jackpot with the remainder of the pot returned to Ducks Unlimited. The weekly drawing is anticipated to be on Tuesday evenings, to begin once we receive Commission approval. We anticipate that once the Queen of Hearts is drawn, sometime between week one and 54 of the game, we would begin a new game the following week.
