**1951 TAX DEED/DWIGHT GUBBRUD, ATTORNEY FOR DTRC, LLC.:** Dwight Gubbrud gave an overview of the 1951 Treasurer's tax deed concerning Monte Cristo No. 1 and Monte Cristo No. 3 of M.S. 1677, Lawrence County, SD. Mr. Gubbrud is working with his client DTRC, LLC. to clear title to mineral interests to those two lodes. Gubbrud explained that he planned to file a quit title action in furtherance of his effort to clear title to the mineral interest.
